2. Update on Web Content Management System

Pilots are started in University College and Advisement Center

Shadow pilots at HSC and IT

Implementation is a little behind schedule

Roll out planned for departments by summer

Unified training to be planned for the whole campus

Widely available, easy to access, hands-on workshops, focusing on the benefits Training responsibility will be shared by IT, Marketing and HSC

Currently the only web policy on campus is in Health Sciences

Although many departments have adopted the UNM template there are still quite a few non-standard sites.

Basic web standards are not being met (links to UNM home, how to apply etc) Accessibility standards are not being met

Issues arise when sites are designed by students or others who then leave UNM Many departments have few resources for managing their own department sites
